This hotel is 15 miles south of downtown Salt Lake City, just off the 15 Freeway at W 7200 S, just one mile south of the 215 Freeway. Please make your reservations by calling the hotel direct and reference **Group #302**. Reservations should be made prior to June 29th to receive the contracted rate. We are holding 20 total rooms until that time. Standard Rooms for our event will be approximately \$58.50.

The La Quinta Inn Salt Lake City/Midvale is convenient to South Towne Expo Center (conventions & trade shows), and close to all major ski resorts. They are just 18 minutes from downtown Salt Lake City (Mormon Temple, Salt Palace, Delta Center, Trolley Square, University of Utah), the South Jordan Equestrian Center, and West Jordan River biking and walking trails.
